

Directions to Christ Church Halton

[updated September 2011]

The address of Christ Church Halton is :- Chapel Street, Halton, Leeds **LS15 7RW** (if you wish to use websites such as multimap/streetmap etc. or satnav guidance)

Bus routes We are on the 40 and 40A bus route – there is a stop in Chapel Street right outside the Church. This service runs every 10 minutes from Leeds City Centre. Use the bus stop on City Square as it goes into Boar Lane.

The No 19 and 19A use the same bus bay. The 19A stops on Selby Road (get off opposite the Co-op) and it is 2 minutes walk. The No.19 takes another route (through the Templegates) from the top of Halton Hill although you can get off there and walk 5 minutes.

Driving For those driving and unfamiliar with the locality there are three major routes:-

A1-M1 link (immediately below) and from Garforth;
A58 central motorway and A64 York Road from Leeds City Centre;
A6120 outer ring road (picking it up at Seacroft)

From A1- M1 Link (and from Garforth)

Please note that new road layout, numbering and signage has come into effect in recent years. Parts of the A63 are now the B6159 (the A63 now goes from the A1/M1 link junction 45 to the centre of Leeds)

- At junction 46 leave the M1 [signposted A6120 ring road]
- **From the south** - on the slip road there are traffic lights. Be in the nearside lane on the slip road and turn left and after the hatch-marks keep in the middle lane of the dual carriageway. [**From the north** there are initially only two lanes turning right –.... (Those approaching via A63 from Garforth should be in the nearside lane for the motorway roundabout then follow the instructions above)]
- Passing through a set of Pelican lights **keep in middle lane**. The nearside lane then bears left for the Retail Park complex but you need to go straight ahead through the lights at the junction.
- Past the junction Sainsbury's complex at Colton should now be on your left-hand side. .Keep in the **nearside** lane passing through two sets of pelican lights and at the next roundabout take the second exit (B6159 Selby Road signposted Halton).
- Continue along Selby Road straight ahead through the first set of (double) traffic lights at the St Mary's Church /Brown Cow and Dragon junction,
- Go through one set of pedestrian pelican lights and just before the next set of pelican lights turn right [into Pinfold Lane]
- At the end of Pinfold Lane (very narrow) turn left into Chapel Street. [At the end of Pinfold Lane you should see the Post Office on your right]

- Take the third right (immediately before Christ Church) and first left into the car park of the church. If full, park on the neighbouring streets at the side of or behind the church or for very large events you can park nearby behind Matalan (ask members of Christ Church for details).

A58 central motorway and A64 York Road from Leeds City Centre

- Follow A64 (York) signs. You will be leaving town from the underpasses or junctions joining the A64.
- Continue on the dual carriageway until the start of the guided busway (which runs between the dual carriageway).
- Shortly afterwards you will approach traffic lights with a pedestrian bridge over the road at Harehills Lane. There will be three lanes at the traffic lights. Come into the **middle** lane if possible and go straight ahead.
- After the traffic lights at Harehills Lane keep in the offside lane (nearest the continuation of the guided busway) through several sets of lights until the end of that section of the busway. **Signal right** and follow the signs for **Halton** and **Temple Newsam House**. At this (the Halton Dial junction) take the inner of the lanes turning right to go under the railway bridge at the bottom of **Halton Hill**.
- Stay in the **nearside lane** and approach the top of the hill (where the road there splits into your nearside lane, a very short bus lane and a right-hand lane to Temple Newsam Road and the **Temple Newsam House**).
- You should see the new Lidl supermarket on your right.
- Go straight ahead through a further set of lights and one set of Pelican lights and approach a zebra crossing.
- Turn left immediately after the zebra into **Chapel Street** and Christ Church will be on your left after 20 yards. [It's a modern two-storey building as shown on our homepage <http://www.urcyorkshire.org.uk/rl.html>]
- Turn first left after the church and left again into the Church car park.

From A6120 Outer Ring Road

- These instructions start from the A6120 at the A64 Seacroft roundabout
- At the next roundabout turn right for the A64 to Leeds City Centre. Follow the dual carriageway until you come to a very large **wooded** roundabout/junction and follow signs for City Centre.
- Keep to nearside lane passing Seacroft Hospital on your left and the large Asda shopping complex on your right shortly after.
- The central guided bus lane (both directions) starts shortly after the traffic lights for the entrance to Asda etc
- Pass through a set of Pelican lights and at the next set of lights turn left on the slip road at Halton Dial and go under the railway bridge.
- Stay in the nearside lane and approach the top of the hill (where there the road splits into your two lanes, a short bus lane and right to Temple Newsam Road and the House. Go straight ahead
- You should have the new Lidl supermarket on your right.
- Go through one set of Pelican lights and approach a zebra crossing.
- Turn left immediately after the zebra into **Chapel Street** and Christ Church will be on your left after 20 yards.
- Turn first left immediately after the church and left again into the Church car park.
