

Knit Triangular shawl pattern

300gm Aran weight yarn or light chunky weight and size 7mm or 7.5mm needles (long or circular). Use a colour change yarn for lovely effects.

Abbreviations: p2tog = purl two together. Yrn = yarn round needle. Yon = yarn over needle

Cast on 4 sts

K 2 rows.

3rd row - (right side) K1, inc into back of this st, k to last two sts, K1, inc into back of this st, K1

4th row K1, *p2tog, yrn* to last three sts, p2tog, yon, K1

5th row As 3rd row

6th row - k to end

7th row As 3rd row

8th row k1, p to last

St. k1.

9th row As 3rd row

10th row K to end.



Repeat rows 3-10, remembering to K1 at each end of purl rows, until 156 sts are on needles, and ending with 10th row. You can work a few more pattern repeats at this stage, then work 3 rows garter stitch. Cast off knitwise on next row. Sew in ends.
