# The Briefing – Number 69 7th<sup>th</sup> October 2021

Dear Friends,

We are back to where we are meant to be, and welcome to the first Thursday in October. This week sees the meeting of Synod, in another new format. Tonight sees a session of Zoom and on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> October sees the first physical meeting of the whole body of Synod since October 2019 when we all met at Herringthorpe. The log in details for the tonight's part of the meeting are with your church synod representatives, church secretaries and ministers. On Saturday we are spending the morning with Longcauseway Church in Dewsbury. I would like to take this opportunity to say thank you on behalf of Synod for the gracious way in which the good folk at Longcauseway have invited us in. I hope that this split meeting will open up the



proceedings to a greater number than would normally attend, especially as the Saturday session will be live streamed on the Yorkshire URC YouTube channel at <a href="https://bit.ly/urcyorkshireyoutube">https://bit.ly/urcyorkshireyoutube</a>. I am reminded to ask you that once you do, please like the page and sign up for updates. As with all things new, we would like to hear your feedback as that will be taken into account when we begin planning the Spring 2022 meeting. There is still a great deal going on and in the weeks after our Synod meeting I hope to be able to bring you a resume of the decisions that were made.

One thing not to forget about is that we still need to be acutely aware of the Covid-19 situation. From personal experience I know that it is still running through our communities, especially schools so let's continue to be careful in the way we open up our church buildings this autumn. 
# **Children and Young Peoples News**


